Easter Triduum Schedule

Holy Thursday April 21st

Liturgy of the Lord's Supper.....7:00 p.m.

Please remember to bring your gifts of food for the Food Box Program with you into Church on Holy Thursday and come prepared for the washing of the disciples' feet. The Community Building will be open for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament after the liturgy until 11:00 p.m.

Good Friday April 22nd

Liturgy of the Hours I.....Noon - 12:30

Liturgy of the Lord's Passion.....12:30 - 2 p.m.

During which we will experience the Passion of our Lord, pass the cross and gather around it in prayer.

Liturgy of the Hours II.....2:00-3:00 pm

Holy Saturday April 23rd

Easter Vigil*please note new time*.....8:30 p.m.

The Paschal fire is lit, the Catechumens are baptized and Confirmed and then celebrate their first Communion. Reception follows after the Mass. **(Please note: There is no 5 p.m. Mass on April 23rd.)**

Easter Sunday April 24th

Adult Masses..... 7am & 11:30 am

Children/Families..... 8:30 & 10:00 am

The 8:30 a.m. Mass is usually a little less crowded than the 10 a.m. Mass, but remember to come early for all the Masses to find a seat. All are welcome.

Please note: There will be no 6 pm Mass on Easter Sunday.

As we begin Holy Week, we enter into a special time of retreat, reflection and prayer.

We come together each year as God's people to celebrate in a special way the death and resurrection of our Lord.

This should be a time set aside for contemplation, a time set aside to be attentive to God.

A time when we hear the stories of our faith, handed down through the millennia.

Savor this time. See the glistening oils, smell the incense, taste the bread, feel the water, touch the cross. Sing and pray, remember and celebrate.
